

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2216, AS REPORTED
(SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS, 2001)
OFFERED BY MR. TOOMEY OF PENNSYLVANIA

In chapter 9 of title II, strike the item relating to
“Federal Emergency Management Agency”.

At the end of the bill, insert after the last section
(preceding the short title) the following:

1 SEC. - - (a) GOVERNMENT-WIDE RESCISSION. -

2 (1) There is hereby rescinded an amount equal to 0.33
3 percent of the new discretionary budget authority provided
4 (or obligation limit imposed) for fiscal year 2001 in this
5 or any other Act for each department,, agency, instrumen-
6 tality, or entity of the Government.

7 (2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to budget accounts
8 included under major functional category 050 (national
9 defense).

10 (b) RESTRICTIONS.-In carrying out the rescissions
11 made by subsection (a) (1), no program, project, or activity
12 of any department, agency, instrumentality, or entity may
13 be reduced by more than 15 percent (with “programs
14 projects, and activities” as delineated in the appropriation
15 Act or accompanying report for the relevant account, or
16 for accounts and items not included in appropriation Acts,



1 as delineated in the President's most recently submitted
2 budget).

3 (c) REPORT.---The Director of the Office of Manage-
4 ment and Budget shall include in the President's budget
5 submission for fiscal year 2003 a report specifying the re-
6 ductions made to each account pursuant to this section.
