**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1950, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. ACKERMAN OF NEW YORK AND  
MR. KING OF NEW YORK**

Page 14, strike lines 1 through 4, and insert the following:

1                   (5) PROTECTION OF FOREIGN MISSIONS  
2                   AND OFFICIALS.—

3                   (A) For "Protection of Foreign Mis-  
4                   sions and Officials", \$25,000,000 for the  
5                   fiscal year 2004 and \$25,000,000 for the  
6                   fiscal year 2005.

7                   (B) In addition to amounts authorized  
8                   to be appropriated by subparagraph (A),  
9                   there is authorized to be appropriated  
10                  \$30,600,000 for "Protection of Foreign  
11                  Missions and Officials" only to reimburse  
12                  the City of New York for necessary ex-  
13                  penses incurred since 1999 for the protec-  
14                  tion of foreign missions and officials.

15                  (C) Notwithstanding section 34 of the  
16                  State Department Basic Authorities Act of  
17                  1956 (22 U.S.C. 2706), the Secretary is  
18                  authorized to reprogram not more than  
19                  \$5,000,000 of funds otherwise authorized
