Page 70, after line 2 insert the following (and amend the table of contents accordingly):

1 **SEC. 231. INTERFERENCE WITH PROTECTIVE FUNCTIONS.**

2 (a) OFFENSE.—Chapter 7 of title 18, United States
3 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following:

4 **“§ 117. Interference with certain protective functions**

5 “Whoever knowingly and willfully obstructs, resists,
6 or interferes with a Federal law enforcement agent en-
7 gaged, within the United States or the special maritime
8 territorial jurisdiction of the United States, in the per-
9 formance of the protective functions authorized by section
10 37 of the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956
11 (22 U.S.C. 2709) or section 103 of the Diplomatic Secu-
12 rity Act (22 U.S.C. 4802) shall be fined under this title
13 or imprisoned not more than one year, or both.”.

14 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
15 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding
16 at the end the following new item:

“117. Interference with certain protective functions.”.
