

30. AN AMENDMENT TO BE OFFERED BY REPRESENTATIVE
LANTOS OF CALIFORNIA, OR
HIS DESIGNEE, DEBATABLE FOR 10 MINUTES:

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1950, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. LANTOS OF CALIFORNIA**

In section 1713 of the bill (relating to enhanced police training)—

(1) strike “Section 660(b) of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961” and insert “(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 660(b) of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961”; and

(2) add at the end the following new subsection:

1 (b) NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT.—Section 660 of
2 the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2420) is
3 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
4 section:

5 “(e) Funds may not be obligated for assistance under
6 subsection (b)(8) unless the Secretary of State notifies the
7 Committee on International Relations of the House of
8 Representatives and the Committee on Foreign Relations
9 of the Senate of the amount and nature of the proposed
10 assistance at least 15 days in advance of the proposed obli-
11 gation in accordance with the procedures applicable to re-
12 programming notifications pursuant to section 634A of
13 this Act. Such notification shall include a comprehensive
14 report and, where practicable, a plan describing the police
15 assistance and rule of law programs of relevant United

- 2 ance under section 660(b)(8).”.
