HEFLEY OF COLORADO, OR
HIS DESIGNEE, DEBATABLE FOR 10 MINUTES:

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1950, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. HEFLEY OF COLORADO**

After section 1312 of the bill, insert the following new section (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

**1 SEC. 1313. CONDITION ON THE PROVISION OF CERTAIN
2 FUNDS TO INDONESIA.**

3 (a) CONDITION ON ASSISTANCE.—Subject to sub-
4 section (c), no funds made available under section 23 of
5 the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2763) or chapter
6 5 of part II of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22
7 U.S.C. 2347 et seq.) in fiscal year 2004, other than funds
8 made available for expanded military education and train-
9 ing under such chapter, may be available for a program
10 that involves the Government of Indonesia or the Indo-
11 nesian Armed Forces until the President makes the certifi-
12 cation described in subsection (b).

13 (b) CERTIFICATION.—The certification referred to in
14 subsection (a) is a certification submitted by the President
15 to the appropriate congressional committees that the Gov-
16 ernment of Indonesia and the Indonesian Armed Forces
17 are taking effective measures, including cooperating with
18 the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation—



1 (1) to conduct a full investigation of the attack
2 on United States citizens in West Papua, Indonesia
3 on August 31, 2002; and

4 (2) to criminally prosecute the individuals re-
5 sponsible for such attack.

6 (c) LIMITATION.—Nothing in this section shall pro-
7 hibit the United States Government from continuing to
8 conduct programs or training with the Indonesian Armed
9 Forces, including counterterrorism training, officer visits,
10 port visits, or educational exchanges that are being con-
11 ducted on the date of the enactment of this Act.
