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**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2417, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MS. LEE OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of title III, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 345. REPORT ON INTELLIGENCE SHARING WITH**  
2 **UNITED NATIONS WEAPONS INSPECTORS**  
3 **SEARCHING FOR WEAPONS OF MASS DE-**  
4 **STRUCTION IN IRAQ.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Comptroller General of the  
6 United States shall conduct a study to determine the ex-  
7 tent to which intelligence developed by the Department of  
8 Defense and by the intelligence community with respect  
9 to weapons of mass destruction obtained or developed by  
10 Iraq preceding Operation Iraqi Freedom was made avail-  
11 able to the United Nations weapons inspectors and the  
12 quantity and quality of the information that was provided  
13 (if any).

14 (b) SPECIFIC MATTER STUDIED.—The study shall  
15 provide for an analysis of the sufficiency of the intelligence  
16 provided by the Director of Central Intelligence to those  
17 weapons inspectors, and whether the information was pro-  
18 vided in a timely manner and in a sufficient quantity and  
19 quality to enable the inspectors to locate, visit, and con-  
20 duct investigations on all high and medium value sus-  
21 pected sites of weapons of mass destruction.

1 (c) ACCESS TO INFORMATION.—(1) Subject to para-  
2 graph (2), the Comptroller General may secure directly  
3 from any agency or department of the United States infor-  
4 mation necessary to carry out the study under subsection  
5 (a).

6 (2) The appropriate Federal agencies or departments  
7 shall cooperate with the Comptroller General in expedi-  
8 tiously providing appropriate security clearances to indi-  
9 viduals carrying out the study to the extent possible pursu-  
10 ant to existing procedures and requirements, except that  
11 no person shall be provided with access to classified infor-  
12 mation under this section without the appropriate security  
13 clearances.

14 (d) REPORT.—Not later than 12 months after the  
15 date of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General  
16 shall submit to Congress a report on the study conducted  
17 under subsection (a). The report shall be submitted in un-  
18 classified form, but may contain a classified annex.
